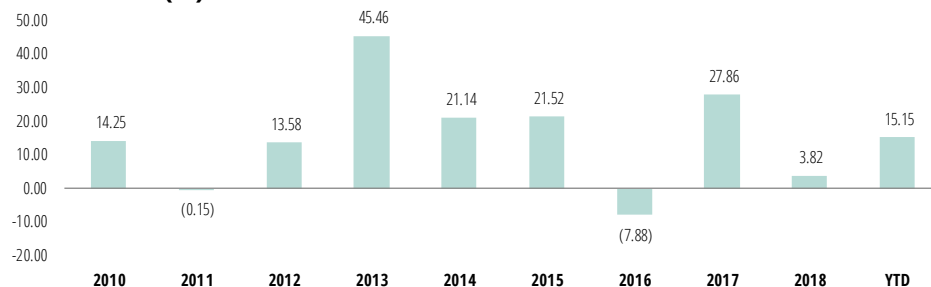

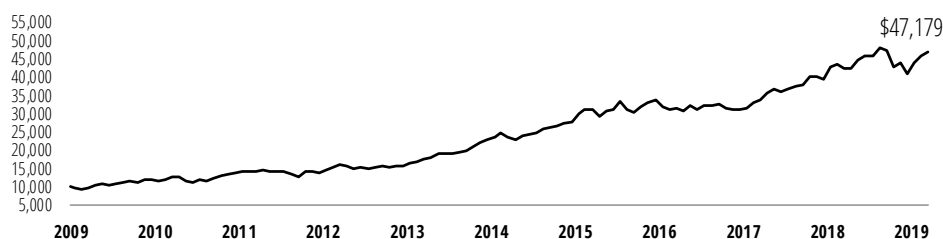

Performance (%) Calendar Year Returns

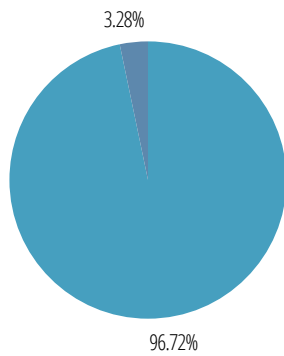


Historical Performance (\$) Current Value of a \$10,000 Investment

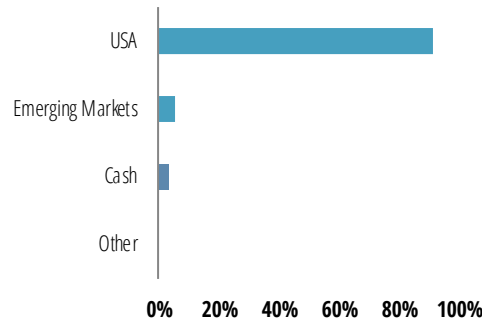


Investment Mix ■ Equities ■ Bonds (Fixed Income) ■ Cash

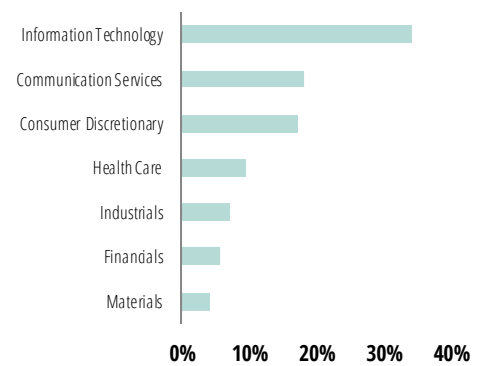
Asset Class Mix
