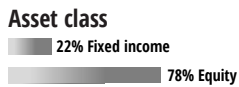

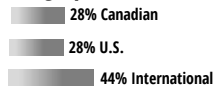

Geographic



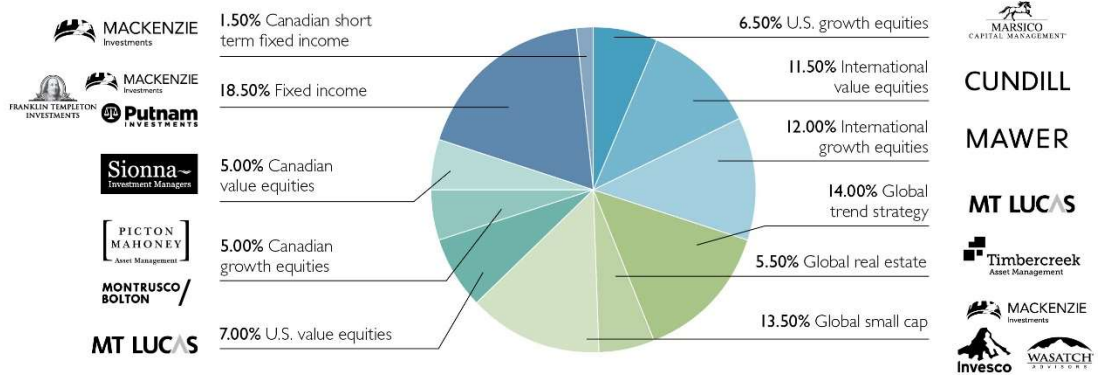

Target Portfolio Allocation¹



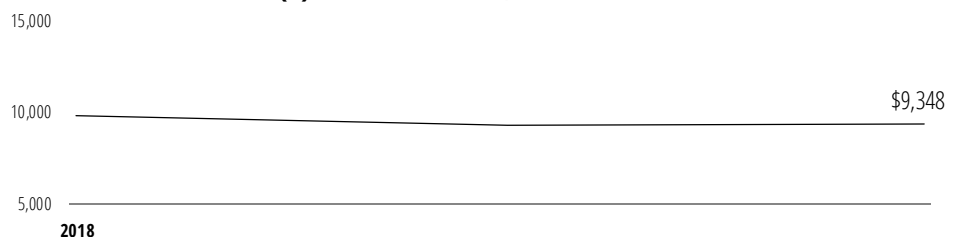

Historical Performance (\$) Current Value of a \$10,000 Investment

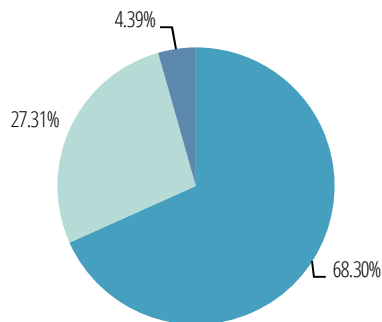

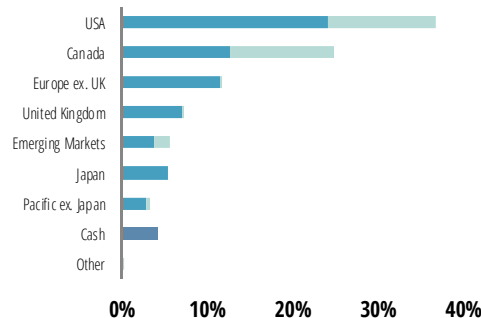
Investment Mix

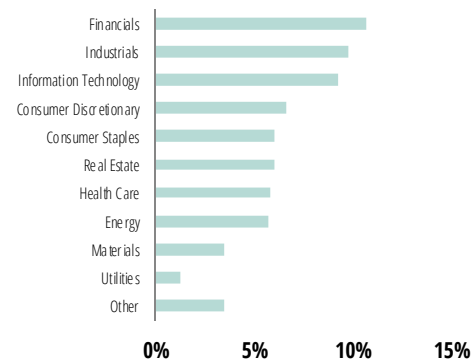
Asset Class Mix
